Subject:- No Objection Certificate/Essentiality Certificate to start GNM Nursing course with intake of 60 seats at Gurukul School of Nursing, Vill. Badesh Kalan, Tehsil Khamano, Distt. Fatehgarh Sahib.

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In reference to the proposal of single file of DRME vide no. 1ME3-Pb-2022/25742 dated 15.12.2022 on the subject cited above. The desired certificate is as follows:-

2. The Principal, Gurukul School of Nursing, Vill. Badesh Kalan, Tehsil Khamano, Distt. Fatehgarh Sahib has applied for establishment of a nursing institute named as Gurukul School of Nursing, Vill. Badesh Kalan, Tehsil Khamano, Distt. Fatehgarh Sahib. On careful consideration of the proposal, the Government of Punjab has decided to issue an essentiality certificate/No Objection Certificate to the applicant starting **GNM Nursing course with an intake of 60 seats** with the following conditions:-

- i) The Institute shall obtain recognition/affiliation from the Indian Nursing council and Punjab Nursing Registration Council, as the case may be before making the admissions.
- ii) No admission shall be made without the prior approval of Punjab Government for which the Institute would submit a separate application after putting up the requisite Building Infrastructure/Machinery & Equipment/Staff /Hostel etc. as per norms of Indian Nursing Council, Govt. of Punjab and Punjab Nurses Registration Council, SAS Nagar and thereafter the institute will request the Punjab Government for inspection.
- iii) The admissions, fee structure and reservation of seats shall be as per Punjab Government instructions and policies issued from time to time.
- iv) The pay scales and emoluments of their staff shall be as per Punjab Government pay scales.
- v) The inspection of the institute shall be carried out on yearly basis up to the completion of the study of first batch of the students. Thereafter, the inspection shall be periodical after three years.
- vi) The project is to be implemented as per the approved project report within prescribed time.
- vii) The Institute shall at all times abide by the conditions laid down by the Punjab Govt./Council etc.
- viii) The Punjab Government will have the right to withdraw the No Objection Certificate if it is found that the Society/applicant has furnished wrong and misleading information or concealed some vital information or if the society / applicant fails to meet any of the conditions of it.

- ix) The institute shall abide by provisions of Punjab Private Health Sciences Educational Institution (Regulations and admission fixation of fee and making reservation) Act, 2006 and as from time to time and Baba Farid University of Health Sciences Act, 1998.
- x) If any of the conditions cited above are not fulfilled by the concerned society/applicant/trust in time, then it will be the responsibility of the Director, Medical Education and Research, Punjab to inform the Government in time.
- xi) The construction work shall be completed within one year and admissions shall be made within 2 years of the issuance of the NOC. The institute shall be allowed to make admission only if it constructs its own building on the proposed land.
- xii) The Government of Punjab reserves the right to withdraw this Essentiality Certificate/No Objection Certificate/permission.
